



- August 2016 Project advertisement






Key Features

Project Phasing

- Construct east side to connect to Capital Beltway Express Lanes and open to traffic.
- Construct west side while maintaining continuous access to Capital Beltway Express Lanes.
- Interim Milestone: Open at least one lane of traffic in each direction for full length.

Construction Features

- 2016 Road and Bridge Specifications
- Standard Limitations of Operations SP will be added by addendum
- Relatively small working area
- Congested area; traveling public
- Requires coordination with multiple parties such as
 - Adjacent construction projects
 - WMATA
 - MWAA
 - Transurban
 - Gates of McLean



Construction Features (cont.)

- ITS Integration
 - Standard VDOT Integration
 - 495 Express Lanes System Integration
- Each organization has a "service commencement" schedule of milestones
- Damage to any 495 Express Lanes Facilities
 - Contactor must pay lost revenue
 - and actual costs for Express Lanes contractor to repair damage with a 25% markup for supervision

 - If an unknown utility is encountered, please contact Miss Utility and project staff
- Facilities located within project limits
 - Out of Plan Adjustments Estimated Completion Fall 2016
 - Verizon
 - Cox
 - Washington Gas
 - Required In-Plan Adjustments
 - Dominion Virginia Power
 - Fairfax Water



Important Utility Provisions and Coordination (cont.)

- In-Plan Utility Work includes Dominion VA Power and Fairfax Water
 - Coordination with VA Power will be required for duct bank construction, wire installations, service cut overs, and wreck out of old facilities
 - Coordination with Fairfax Water will be required for installation, testing, and cut overs
- RFID Markers will be utilized for all utility installations and test holes

 - Usually meets quarterly Costs shared


